

VICTRELIS® (boceprvir) Approved for Hepatitis C Virus

Effective immediately, the FDA has approved VICTRELIS (boceprvir) for the treatment of chronic hepatitis C, genotype 1 infection, to be used in combination with peginterferon alfa and ribavirin. VICTRELIS is for use in adults with compensated liver disease, including cirrhosis, who are previously untreated or who have failed treatment with combination therapy.

Product Information

- VICTRELIS is available as 200 mg capsules.
- The recommended dosage regimen is 800 mg orally three times a day.
- VICTRELIS must be administered in combination with peginterferon alfa and ribavirin.
- Patient package inserts and counseling information are available for patient use.

Adverse Reactions

- Common adverse reactions (>35%) in clinical trials include fatigue, anemia, nausea, headache and dysgeusia (abnormal taste).
- There are other adverse reactions that have been reported. For a full list of adverse reactions, please refer to the manufacturer's package insert.

Use in Specific Populations

- Boceprvir is contraindicated in pregnant women and in men whose female partner is pregnant.
- Safety and efficacy has not been studied in patients with decompensated cirrhosis or patients who have had an organ transplant.
- Safety and efficacy has not been established in patients co-infected with hepatitis C and HIV.
