

XIAFLEX® Available Through CoramRx

Xiaflex (collagenase clostridium histolyticum), from Auxilium Pharmaceuticals, is now available from CoramRx for the treatment of adult patients with Dupuytren's contracture with a palpable cord.

Product Information

- XIAFLEX is available in a single-use glass vial containing 0.9 mg of collagenase clostridium histolyticum powder for reconstitution.
- XIAFLEX should be administered by a healthcare provider experienced in injections of the hand and Dupuytren's contracture.
- The initial XIAFLEX dose is 0.58 mg injected into a Dupuytren's cord with a contracture of a metacarpophalangeal joint or proximal joint. If a contracture persists approximately 24 hours after injection, a finger extension procedure should be performed. Up to three injections per cord may be done at four-week intervals.
- Patient package inserts and counseling information are available for distribution to the patient.

Adverse Reactions

- Common adverse reactions reported in >25% of patients were: peripheral edema, contusion, injection site reaction, injection site hemorrhage, and pain in the extremity.

Use in Specific Populations

- **Pregnancy:** Because no well-controlled studies in pregnant women have been conducted, XIAFLEX should only be used in this population if clearly needed.
